#### Activities Description:

Appleton YMCA- Members will be able to use the YMCA facilities in activities of their choice.

Birthday Club- Peer group in which member's send birthday wishes for members with March birthdays through sending out birthday cards. We will also celebrate all members with birthdays in the month.
