### Activities Description:

- Adulting 101: ORC staff will offer supportive coaching on exploring new topics that people face as they continue to grow and mature.
- Appleton YMCA- Members will be able to use the YMCA facilities in activities of their choice. Members are required to sign up in advance of this activity.
- Art/Crafting Club- Members will explore different art and crafting activities while engaging with other peers.
- Bay Beach- Being social in the community outing. Members will enjoy activities and rides at the amusement park. Please bring own money for food and dress appropriately for day along with sunscreen if needed.
- Bingo- Socialize with peers while playing a center favorite. Prizes will be given to winners.
- Birthday Club- Peer group in which member's send birthday wishes for members with June birthdays through sending out birthday cards. We will also celebrate all members with birthdays in the month.
- Board and Card Games- Members will be able to free play available board and card games and test their skills.
- Book Club- Peer group to engage others in conversation based on story, article, or book being read by the group.
- CHAMPS Cooking- St. Joe's Food Program provide ingredients and nutritional instruction for cooking activity.
- Community Spotlight Presentation (Mental Health Navigator)- VPI's Mental Health Navigator Program will share information about the program, services offered, etc.
- Cookbook Cooking- Members will learn cooking skills that will focus on following given recipe to make food dish.
- Cornhole at ORC- Members will engage with one another in this recreational activity.
- Creative Writing- Members will explore different writing platforms and have opportunities to try new writing styles.
- EAA Aviation Museum- Learning from the community outing. Members will view and explore the current exhibits of the museum.
- Gaming Club- Members will socialize through Wii gaming activities, card games, and board games.
- Gardening Club- Members will begin planting seeds to start an ongoing garden at the ORC.
- Gay/Straight Alliance- Group that promotes education, awareness, and support for the LGBTQ+ community and its allies. All members welcome to participate.
- Healthy Cooking- Healthy cooking activity in which members learn skills for preparing meal that fit within set budgets.
- Life Skills Group- Members will learn and practice different skills that can be used at any time in a person's life.

- Member's Choice Activity- Members will independently choose from available activities at the ORC.
- Mental Health Group- Educational group to explore different areas and topics of Mental Health in the community and in day-to-day life.
- Movie Discussion Group- This member led group will have members view a movie and then discuss key aspects of movie.
- Music Group- Peer run group for music lovers. Members will be able to jam with other members while learning, playing various musical instruments. This will be a free style, play as you like format.
- Neshota Park- Getting active in the community outing. Members will walk the trails and explore what the park has to offer.
- ORC Scavenger Hunt- Test your observation skills with this interactive activity to following clues and discovery hidden gems at the center or in the community.
- Outings Planning- Members discuss and plan outings/activities to be scheduled for the month of July that meet our categories of outings. Members use planning and budgeting skills for this planning.
- Relationship Group- Members will explore relationships from friendships to significant others. Members will be encouraged to share topics to be discussed and participate in open discussions.
